We recognize the hardship high energy bills can pose for our customers, particularly during this summer of record-breaking temperatures.

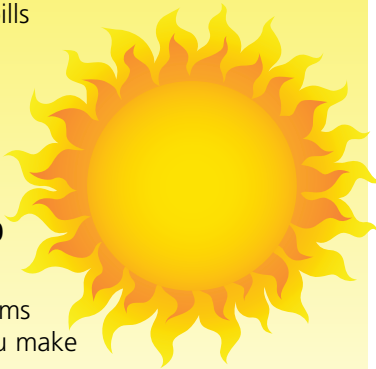
If you're having a difficult time paying your electricity bill, we're here to help.

- Preparing an emergency survival kit to include a flashlight, battery-powered radio, fresh batteries, essential medication, nonperishable food, and enough fresh water to last several days.
- Developing a contingency plan. Decide where to go in the event of a lengthy power outage such as seeking temporary shelter with family or friends.

Current customer information allows us to provide the quickest response to your outage issue.

Solar Decathlon Begins Sept. 23
