

New Rates for Maryland Standard Offer Service Customers

Pepco's Standard Offer Service (SOS) supply rates for Maryland residential customers will decrease June 1, 2010. If you have not chosen an alternative electricity supplier, you are on Standard Offer Service and Pepco buys electricity for you.

For residential customers, the new supply rates will decrease the total annual bill by about 8.9 percent. For a typical residential customer who uses about 1,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity a month, this will result in a monthly decrease of about \$13.80 from about \$155.60 to \$141.80 on the total bill.

The proposed new rates are based on market prices obtained through a competitive bidding process overseen by the Maryland Public Service Commission. This year's supply auction replaced some older, lower-priced supply contracts, resulting in higher prices for customers.

Below are the new residential SOS supply rates which take effect on June 1. To help you evaluate offers if you choose to shop for an alternative electricity supplier, the "price to compare" for "Generation and Transmission Services" for the average residential customer is 11.07 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh). This is an average and your "price to compare" could be lower or higher.
