

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from April 15, 2019 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2021.

A total of six (6) bid blocks were offered representing approximately 25% of the load and totaling approximately 326 MW PLC at time of bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 12 eligible bidders in the 2018-2019 RFP Procurement Process of which 11 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the entire load offered.

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three-month term for June 1, 2019 through August 31, 2019.

A total of four (4) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 208 MW PLC at time of bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 12 eligible bidders in the 2018-2019 RFP Procurement Process of which 8 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won the entire load offered.
