

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from April 23, 2018 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2020.

A total of seven (7) bid blocks were offered representing approximately 30% of the load and totaling approximately 377.6 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 12 eligible bidders in the 2017 – 2018 RFP Procurement Process of which 8 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won the entire load offered.

Pepco Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three-month term for June 2018 through August 2018.

A total of four (4) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 201.9 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 12 eligible bidders in the 2017 – 2018 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won the entire load offered.
