

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 16, 2017 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2018 through May 31, 2020.

A total of five (5) bid blocks were offered representing approximately 20% of the load, and totaling approximately 250 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 10 eligible bidders in the 2017 – 2018 RFP Procurement Process of which 9 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won the entire load offered.

Pepco Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three-month term for December 2017 through February 2018.

A total of four (4) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and approximately 49.1 MW PLC at time of Bid. This requirement was filled.

There were 10 eligible bidders in the 2017 – 2018 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the entire load offered.
