

WINTER RATES RETURN FOR PEPCO DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA CUSTOMERS

Pepco's Standard Offer Service (SOS) supply rates for District of Columbia residential customers will change to winter rates effective November 1, 2018. If you have not chosen a competitive supplier, you are on SOS supply rates and Pepco buys electricity for you. The cost of supply rates is shown in the "Generation Services" and "Transmission Services" sections of your bill.

The new rates are based on market prices obtained through a competitive bidding process overseen by the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia. Pepco, as with many other utilities, charges different rates for electricity use in the winter (November-May) and in the summer (June-October).

In addition, beginning August 13, 2018, customers began receiving two ongoing federal tax savings credits, which reflect tax savings that customers will receive for the next five and ten years. The credits are listed in the rate chart on the reverse side as "5 and 10 Year Excess Deferred Income Tax (EDIT) Credit".

* Residential customers will receive a \$1.37 credit on their bills and Master Meter Apartment customers will receive a \$0.17 credit on their bills starting 8/13/2018 through the Exelon Customer Base Rate Credit (CBRC), a benefit from Pepco’s merger with Exelon. The CBRC will terminate when its funding balance is exhausted.

** Minimum charge includes (1) the first 30 kWh or fraction thereof of consumption, and (2) administrative charge.

*** The administrative charge must be added to the generation rates stated above.
