

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from April 27, 2020 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2022.

A total of seven (7) bid blocks were offered representing approximately 30% of the load and totaling approximately 363 MW PLC at time of bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 15 eligible bidders in the 2019-2020 RFP Procurement Process of which 12 suppliers submitted bids and 4 suppliers won the entire load offered.

Pepco Type II Non-Residential

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three-month term for June 2020 through August 2020.

A total of four (4) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 214 MW PLC at time of bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 15 eligible bidders in the 2019-2020 RFP Procurement Process of which 8 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won the entire load offered.
