

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 21, 2019 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2020 through May 31, 2022.

A total of five (5) bid blocks were offered representing approximately 20% of the load and totaling approximately 241 MW PLC at time of bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 15 eligible bidders in the 2019-2020 RFP Procurement Process of which 11 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the entire load offered.

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three-month term for December 2019 through February 2020.

A total of four (4) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 204 MW PLC at time of bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 15 eligible bidders in the 2019-2020 RFP Procurement Process of which 8 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won the entire load offered.
