We want to make sure you have what you need to keep powering on, so if you are facing financial challenges, there are programs to help you now and in the future. We've provided information on the back of this insert about energy assistance programs for District of Columbia residents. Your eligibility is based on the income your household received in the last 30 days. We encourage you to take a minute to read about the available programs and apply for the assistance you may need.

Eligibility is based on your combined household income and the number of residents for the listed programs. Check this chart to determine your eligibility.

## District of Columbia Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

- Provides financial assistance with your home heating bills
- Eligibility is based on the type of dwelling, heating source, total household income and size
- Benefit is \$250–\$1800

## Residential Aid Discount Program (RAD)

- The District Department of Energy and Environment qualifies RAD participants from customers eligible for the LIHEAP program.
- You can apply to be on RAD via the District Department of Energy and Environment
- RAD provides qualified customers with a monthly discount called the "Residential Aid Credit"
- The RAC covers the following charges: the full customer charge for distribution, the Residential Aid Discount Surcharge, the Sustain Energy Trust Fund and the Energy Assistance Trust Fund

## Arrearage Management Program (AMP)

- You must enroll in the Residential Aid Discount program and must have a minimum balance of \$300 that is at least 60 days past due to be eligible.
- A monthly credit is deducted from your existing arrearage when full monthly payments made

## Greater Washington Urban League (GWUL)

- Eligible customers receive grants for their Pepco bill on a case-by-case basis
- You must be a resident of the District of Columbia

## Washington Area Fuel Fund (WAFF)

- Helps qualified customers pay their heating bills
