

NEW ELECTRIC SUPPLY RATES BEGIN JUNE 1 FOR MARYLAND CUSTOMERS

Pepco's Standard Offer Service (SOS) supply rates for Maryland residential customers increased beginning June 1, 2021. If you have not chosen an alternative electricity supplier, you are on SOS and Pepco buys electricity for you.

For a typical residential customer who uses about 1,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity a month, this will result in a monthly increase of about \$6.21 from about \$126.66 to \$132.87 on the total bill.

The new rates are based on market prices obtained through a competitive bidding process overseen by the Maryland Public Service Commission.
