

# WINTER RATES RETURN FOR PEPCO DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA CUSTOMERS

Pepco's Standard Offer Service (SOS) supply rates for District of Columbia residential customers will change to winter rates effective November 1, 2022. If you have not chosen a competitive supplier, you are on SOS supply rates and Pepco buys electricity for you. The cost of supply rates is shown in the "Generation Services" and "Transmission Services" sections of your bill.

The new rates are based on market prices obtained through a competitive bidding process overseen by the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia. Pepco, as with many other utilities, charges different rates for electricity use in the winter (November–May) and in the summer (June–October).
