**FORMAL CASE NO. 1176, APPLICATION OF
POTOMAC ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY FOR
AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT A MULTIYEAR RATE
PLAN FOR ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SERVICE**

Pepco's "Climate Ready Pathway DC" multi-year plan, currently pending with the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (PSC), outlines investments the company will make from 2024-2026 to support a climate ready grid and enable cleaner energy programs and technologies. The plan also includes projects and initiatives that will enhance the reliability, resiliency and security of the local energy grid, as well as efforts to expand assistance to help manage the affordability of energy service for customers across the District. Pursuant to D.C. Code Sections 34-901 and 34-909, Pepco is providing notice of this filing.

If Pepco's Climate Ready Pathway DC plan is approved by the PSC as submitted, it would result in an average monthly increase of \$6.13 for the typical District of Columbia residential electric customer's bill over the three-year period of the multi-year plan. Based on these adjustments the typical residential customer bill will increase from \$97.06 to \$114.66 throughout the duration of the plan.

This booklet contains the proposed changes to distribution rates for each customer class should the PSC fully approve the plan.
