

## STANDARD OFFER SERVICE RATES DECREASE EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2017

Pepco's Standard Offer Service (SOS) supply rates for District of Columbia residential customers will decrease June 1, 2017. If you have not chosen a competitive supplier, you are on SOS supply rates and Pepco buys electricity for you, charging you rates approved by the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (Commission). The cost of SOS supply rate is shown in the "Generation Services" and "Transmission Services" portions of your electric bill.

The new rates are based on market prices obtained through a competitive bidding process overseen by the Commission. The average monthly bill for residential customers is expected to decrease 1.1% or \$0.89 under the new rates. Under Generation Service Charges, the Administrative Charge that was previously included in the kilowatt hour (kWh) rate is listed separately.

Please note that summer rates take effect with the billing month of June. Pepco, as with many other utilities, charges different rates for electricity use in the summer (June–October) and in the winter (November–May).

**RESIDENTIAL AID DISCOUNT (RAD) PROGRAM**

Customers eligible for the RAD program are now billed under residential rate schedules “R” and “AE” and receive a monthly credit – the Residential Aid Credit (RAC). This credit replaces the previous discount that was applied to eligible RAD customers’ distribution, generation and transmission charges on their account and appears under the delivery charges section of their bill.

The RAC covers the following charges:

- The full customer charge for distribution and energy charges for distribution. This is listed as the “RAC – Distribution.”
- The Residential Aid Discount Surcharge, the Sustain Energy Trust Fund and the Energy Assistance Trust Fund. This is listed as the “RAC – Surcharges.”
