

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 19, 2020 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2021 through May 31, 2023.

A total of six (6) bid blocks were offered representing approximately 25% of the load and totaling approximately 324 MW PLC at time of bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 10 eligible bidders in the 2020-2021 RFP Procurement Process of which 9 suppliers submitted bids and 4 suppliers won the entire load offered.

Pepco Type II Non-Residential

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three-month term for December 2020 through February 2021.

A total of four (4) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 212 MW PLC at time of bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 10 eligible bidders in the 2020-2021 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won the entire load offered.
