

Winter Rates Return with November Billing and Important Distribution Rate Changes

Pepco, as with many other utilities, charges different rates for electricity use in the winter (November-May) than it does in summer (June-October). The following charts compare rates between winter and summer periods for different rate schedule categories. The change to winter rates will begin with the billing month of November 2017. Your rate schedule appears in the "Meter Summary" portion of your bill.

Importantly, as a result of a Public Service Commission order effective August 15, 2017, the distribution service for Residential All Electric "AE" and Residential Time Metered "R-TM" are served on rates identical to the Residential "R" rates. Due to the electricity supply bidding process, Standard Offer Service (SOS) customers who were formerly served under "AE" and "RTM" will still have a component of their SOS rate that is calculated using these former rate classifications until 2020. On your bill, these rate classifications will be listed as Residential – Supply AE and Residential – Supply RTM.

Also, effective August 15, 2017, the distribution service for Master Metered Apartments "MMA" is billed under a new rate schedule. Customers who receive Pepco's SOS rates are subject to the Distribution, Transmission and Generation Service charges below. These charges reflect revisions in SOS (generation) rates that took effect June 1, 2017. Customers who have selected an alternative electricity supplier are subject only to the Distribution Service charges below, modified as appropriate by the application of the Billing Credit. For those with an alternative electricity supplier, the Transmission and Generation rates will be supplied by their chosen supplier.
