PROJECT OVERVIEW

At Pepco, we are committed to providing safe, reliable, and affordable energy to our customers and communities in the District of Columbia. As part of this commitment, we are upgrading and modernizing the Harrison Street Substation at 5210 Wisconsin Avenue, NW. While Pepco has operated the substation reliably for more than 70 years, the infrastructure and some of the equipment are nearing the end of their intended service lives and require upgrades.

STRENGTHENING SYSTEMS & PREPARING FOR GROWTH

The modernization of Harrison Street Substation will enhance reliability and prepare for the community's growing energy needs. This work will also improve the aesthetics of the building by enclosing the substation to conceal equipment and upgrading the façade of the building along the 5200 block of Wisconsin Avenue, NW.

IMPACTS ON THE COMMUNITY

We understand that work in your neighborhood can cause disruption such as parking restrictions, and Pepco will work to minimize impacts to residents and the community. We are coordinating with the District of Columbia's Department of Transportation to create traffic control plans to ensure the public and workers are safe while keeping disruption to a minimum. Proper flagging and signage will be used to minimize traffic delays. Pepco will begin work in your area in early September through November 2018. Customer outages will not be necessary as a part of this project.

PROJECT ACTIVITY

Transmission lines at Wisconsin Avenue NW and Van Ness Street NW will be energized to supply power to the newly upgraded Harrison Substation. At 4201 Wisconsin, excavation

will occur on Van Ness, facing the side of the building at 4201. At 4200 Wisconsin, excavation will occur at the Pepco manhole at the corner of Van Ness and Wisconsin.

Excavation is required to gain access to buried lines to complete this work, including installing new cable and preparing the pipe for the new cable installation.

Customers can expect to see Pepco personnel working in the manholes and on the street. We ask customers to remain clear of worksites so that Pepco crews can complete their work safely and efficiently. We appreciate your patience as we complete this important work to improve service in your community.
