

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from April 23, 2012 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2014.

A total of eight (8) bid blocks were offered representing 29.7% of the load, and totaling approximately 398.3 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 13 eligible bidders in the 2012– 2013 RFP Procurement Process of which 10 suppliers submitted bids and 4 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three month term of June, July, and August 2012.

A total of five (5) bid blocks was offered representing 100% of the load and approximately 252.6 MW PLC at time of Bid. This requirement was filled.

There were 13 eligible bidders in the 2012 – 2013 RFP Procurement Process of which 8 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won a portion of the total load offered.
