

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 22, 2012 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2013 through May 31, 2015.

A total of six (6) bid blocks were offered representing 25.0% of the load and totaling approximately 312.0 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 11 eligible bidders in the 2013 – 2014 RFP Procurement Process of which 10 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won of the entire load offered.

Pepco Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three month term for December 2012, January 2013, and February 2013.

A total of five (5) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 257.4 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 11 eligible bidders in the 2013– 2014 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.
