

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 28, 2013 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting June 1, 2014 through May 31, 2016.

A total of five (5) bid blocks were offered representing 20.0% of the load and totaling approximately 244.4 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 10 eligible bidders in the 2014 – 2015 RFP Procurement Process of which 8 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won a share of the load offered.

Pepco Type II Non Residential

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three month term for December 2013, January 2014, and February 2014.

A total of five (5) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 256.8 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 10 eligible bidders in the 2014– 2015 RFP Procurement Process of which 7 suppliers submitted bids and 2 suppliers won a portion of the load offered.
