

Pepco Maryland SOS Bid Results from April 22, 2013 Solicitation

Pepco Residential and Small Commercial

This solicitation included the Residential and Small Commercial 24-Month term starting October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2015.

A total of six (6) bid blocks were offered representing 25.0% of the load and totaling approximately 305.8 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 12 eligible bidders in the 2013 – 2014 RFP Procurement Process of which 10 suppliers submitted bids and 3 suppliers won a share of the load offered.

This solicitation also included the quarter containing the three month term for June, July, and August 2013.

A total of five (5) bid blocks were offered representing 100% of the load and totaling approximately 265 MW PLC at time of Bid. All requirements were filled.

There were 12 eligible bidders in the 2013– 2014 RFP Procurement Process of which 6 suppliers submitted bids and 1 supplier won the entire load offered.
